WeTravel Booking Instructions By e-Check – OR – Credit / Debit Card

- I. Read all Instructions, Terms and Conditions, and Trip Details carefully. Please note that ALL Rates are Per Person.
- II. Under Available Packages: Select your Desired Package Occupancy and click the "Book Now" button until a window pops up.
 - STUDENT PACKAGE (QUINT Occupancy)
 4 students in a room with 2 Double Beds and Pull-Out Sofa Sleeper
 - CHAPERONE PACKAGE (DOUBLE Occupancy) 2 chaperones in a room with 2 Double Beds
- III. On the pop-up window, adjust the number of participants on the left side of the package selected. For example:
 - If booking a Student Package package only for 1 student, the number "1" should be next to the package selected. If booking this package for more than 1 student, adjust the # of participants as needed. If 2 students, select 2, etc.
- IV. Under Payment Options: Select "Pay amount due \$0" and click "Continue"
- V. Under Buyer Information: Fill-in all 4 boxes (First Name, Last Name, Email, Confirm Email)
 - Click the box "Create an account to easily make future payments" (*The "buyer" is the person responsible for making payments and signing the Terms & Conditions)
- VI. E-Sign the Terms & Conditions
- VII. Under Participant Information: fill-in information for the participant(s) you are enrolling and click "Continue to Payment"
 - First Name, Last Name, Email, Cell # of Main Contact (Parent), Parent Name & Email Address, Date of Birth, Participant's Gender, Registration Type, Allergies/Dietary Restrictions
 - Read through all statements/guestions and acknowledge/answer accordingly

VIII. Click "Confirm Booking"

- Note: Please add a default payment method by logging in at note-abletravel.wetravel.com with the same email you are using to register the participant to be automatically charged when the next payment is due. 2.9% CC fee for Visa, Mastercard, Discover or 3.9% CC fee for American Express per transaction (payment installment). There is no additional fee if you pay by e-Check.

Terms and Conditions

- 1. This Program is available only to Brandeis HS Color Guard Students/Chaperones/Staff.
- 2. Participants have until **September 22, 2024,** to enroll in this program -or- until the trip is fully enrolled, whichever occurs first. At that time, if there are still places remaining, the portal will remain open on a first come first serve basis. Once the program is fully subscribed, a waitlist will be started.
- 3. The program cost is based on a minimum of 40 paid participants. Upon enrollment, you are committing to participate in this program. Once the program has 40 participants enrolled, a \$350.00 per person non-refundable deposit is due within 48 hours of receiving notice. If the deposit is not received within those 48 hours, the participant's space on the trip will be released and put on the waitlist.
- 4. The Payment Plan will consist of five (5) Installments. The first installment is the \$350.00 booking deposit, the second (2nd), third (3rd), and fourth (4th) installments are each \$350.00, and the fifth (5th) installment being the final balance due. Each installment payment upon receipt is non-refundable, non-disputable and non-transferable in accordance with the Terms and Conditions for this program. Disputed Payments, if any, will be billed to the Brandeis HS Color Guard.

- 5. If any of the installment payments are 10 or more calendar days late, *without prior arrangements*, it will be treated as a cancellation and the participant's fees paid to that point are non-refundable.
- Should the participant pay more than the required installment amount, the non-refundable portion
 of the payment made will be determined by the date NTE is made aware of the cancelation and
 the Cumulative Cancellation Non-Refundable Amounts based on the installment payment / date
 schedule above.
- 7. Late Payment Exception: Participants/Parents who have an extenuating circumstance that is resulting in payments to be made after the due date, are requested to email team@note-abletravel.com with additional information. Exceptions for late payments will be made on an individual basis.

- 8. **Trip Cancelation**: Participants are asked to email **team@note-abletravel.com** as soon as the need to cancel becomes apparent.
- 9. Participant enrollments and payments are non-transferable.
